Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, Baseball Nova Scotia will further extend its suspension of all in person activities to June 1st, 2020.

While we want to see everyone on the field as soon as safely possible, we encourage our members to respect the rules and regulations communicated from the Provincial Government. By respecting the social distancing measures put in place, it increases the chances of a baseball season being possible in 2020.

In the coming weeks, we will see local towns and recreational departments commence their spring maintenance of ball fields. This will create tempting conditions for our baseball starved members to jump a fence and take advantage of the conditions. Please remember, these facilities are still closed. By breaking the rules now, you will only slow down the efforts of those responsible for field maintenance in preparing facilities for a proper opening day.

Next week, Baseball Nova Scotia will be releasing a contingency plan for the 2020 season. As we are all preparing for a condensed season, a ripple effect will be seen across all programming as dates are adjusted. Accompanying this plan, will be an FAQ sheet outlining the answers to questions BNS has been most commonly receiving over the past number of weeks.
